Government

Administration of health related services

- Any person engaged in the administration of health related services
- Examples include: Doctors, Physiotherapists, Aged Care Workers, Disability Support workers
- Must reside in Queensland

Other

Member of a mutual bank or credit union established for employees of any Australian state or federal police service, armed services, or customs and border protection service.

An applicant can apply for membership with QBANK if they have a relative (immediate family only) who is an existing member with QBANK (not in the process of becoming a member). E.g. Spouse, Defacto, partner, parents, grandparents, children or siblings.

Any former employee/member of these groups are eligible for membership with QBANK. They can demonstrate eligibility by providing previous payslips, tax return etc.
